In the spring the billboards were put for the first-time during the *Day of the Conceived Child* campaign throughout Slovakia. During the year we offered the concrete help, gathered experience and specific advise was given in the first year of the consulting centre *Alexis* and in the third year of the project *Save the Lives*. In the autumn mission *Candle for Unborn Children* we tried to highlight the value of human life from the conception in the churches throughout Slovakia. Thus the news of our members' passing deeply touch us – Paul Stamm, Ladislav Lencz and Ladislav Fülöp. May God give them the eternal rest.

After the Forum for Life Assembly election held on January 23rd, 2010 in Rajecké Teplice we started to perform a strategy accepted by Forum for Life. Its fundamental is the opinion that „ethics and intellect“ belong together and

offer good solutions „in the market“ where the natural law tradition is threatened by the power of money and relativism.

It is indeed a number of activities in advocacy, prevention and specific assistance, where we are ambitious to offer solutions. But we couldn't balance without people in the regions of Slovakia - volunteers, friends, sympathisants, financial and spiritual supporters.

This annual report is the report of all who met in the forum of the Forum for Life. Without their help and support this report wouldn't be.

INTRODUCING THE ORGANIZATION OF FORUM FOR LIFE

Forum for Life vision is to live in a society that respects human life from conception to natural death, and supports the family as the optimal place for formation and development of human life.

The goal of the Forum for Life is to protect every human life from conception to natural death. This goal we implement in three areas:

- a) **Prevention** – we provide information about human dignity from conception to death, prenatal development of the child, the right to life from conception to human life, endangering human life, the reality of abortion, also on natural methods of family planning, relationships based on true love, responsibility and respect for human dignity.
- b) **Advocacy** – we raise our voice to protect those who are unable to defend themselves. We try to promote and support legislation that respects the human dignity of every human being from conception to natural death, and marriage and family as the basic cell of society.
- c) **Concrete help** – we help to solve difficult life situations of women and their children, needy, sick and weak.

Our activities we develop through workers, co-workers, volunteers and our membership base in the regions of Slovakia. Activities of Forum for life is provided by the secretariat with their departments:

legislative, PR pro-life, education, concrete assistance, and regional centers.

Secretariat in addition to the procedural running of the organization provides services for activities of Forum for Life and for members of the Forum for Life, also organizes activities to promote the spiritual culture of life and spiritual activities for members and leadership Forum for Life.

Legislative department continually monitors legislative proposals and prepares proposals to improve legislation and communicates with members of the National Council of the Slovak Republic, European parliament and staff of ministries. Also prepares training materials, materials for media, for the regional centers and for public.

Department of PR pro-life (Public Relations) systematically communicates with the selected target groups, with chosen ways and means brings the value of pro-life and pro-family in order to create positive relations with public, media, members of the Forum for Life, volunteers, workers and partners based on complete and accurate information through the issue of the Newsletter Forum for Life, running websites, sending messages via Email Forum for Life, preparation of lectures and discussions in cooperation with regional centers, preparation of thematic leaflets and brochures and other materials and the implementation of information and education campaigns.

Department for Education and Training through regional centers prepares lectures for public (schools, communities, parishes), prepares educational seminars, in cooperation with regional centers organizes seminars for employees Forum for Life, prepares manuals and materials for organizing courses and seminars. In cooperation with Áno pre život n. o. (Yes for life NGO) prepares the conference - Choose Life, in cooperation with DOMKA and Erko offers pro-life courses and working with the Specialized section for family and responsible parenthood.

Department for Concrete help organizes and implements activities of concrete help (Save lives, Consulting centre for women and girls Alexis in collaboration with other organizations Consulting centre Rachel) and through regional centers is networking members of Forum for Life and co-workers of concrete help.

Department of Regional Centres manages and coordinates the activities of regional centers. Regional centers, the lower branch of the Secretariat FZ implement legislative activities, PR pro-life, education and training, concrete help, internal communications, search, sources of funding and spiritual support in terms of its scope, powers and responsibilities.

Results of operations for 2010 are available in this annual report.



KEY PROJECTS OF FORUM FOR LIFE

March 25th - Day of the Conceived Child

Our annual campaign celebrated this year its 10th year. With the motto: „Even your story began with conception“ we linked the campaign to that of 2009. A brand new feature of this year was placing of 80 billboards throughout Slovakia. About 60,000 leaflets, 2,000 posters, about 20,000 white ribbons were handed out to, 200 to 300 volunteers participated in various activities, more than 3,000 visitors visited the site www.25marec.sk and the TV spot was aired about 500 times. The number of “For Life” Facebook group members was increased to 5900.

International conference Vyber si život (Choose Life)

On 26 – 27 March, 2010 an international conference Vyber si život (Choose Life) was taking place in Rajecké Teplice. Its aim was to give space for discussion about the need to protect human life from conception to natural death. XII. year of the conference was focused on the topic: A woman and her free choice. One of the key lectures of the conference was presented by Prof. Janne Haaland Matlary from Norway. In a lecture entitled „Human rights threatened by power and relativism“ she presented to the participants the essence of human rights that are not being given to the man by the power of the State or the international community, but a man owns them because he is a man – a human being with unique human dignity.

Anton Neuwirth Prize for protection of life

One part of the conference was the 6th year of granting the Anton Neuwirth Prize for the protection of human life. Marián Kuffa was awarded in the category Slovak personality, Dietmar Fischer in the category Foreign personality and in the category Organization the price was given to Hnutie kresťanských rodín na Slovensku (Movement of Christian Families in Slovakia).

Candle for Unborn Children

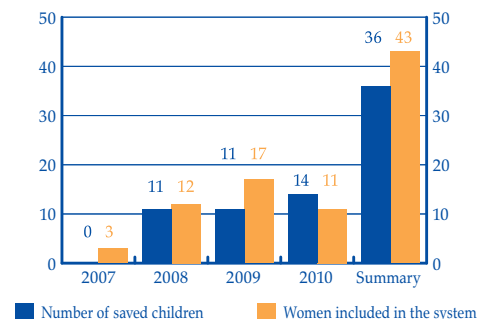
This year’s “Candle” took place already for the eighth time. The project was running throughout the month of October and culminated on the 2nd November, All Souls Day. In the evening of this day we could put a burning candle in the windows of our homes, and thus to express our attitude to life. The project is also associated with a collection in which it is possible to obtain the original Candle for unborn children for a voluntary contribution. We distributed throughout Slovakia 30 000 original candles, 20 000 leaflets with a prayer for respect of life and made hundreds of e-mail, telephone and personal contacts. Proceeds from this action are 37,197 EUR, the direct costs of implementation we quantified to the amount of 8,309 EUR.

Memorials of the Unborn, which are monitored within the project, were expanded up to three new locations, so that together we have data of 18 memorials. This year also two marches for life took place - in Bratislava and Košice.

Save the Lives

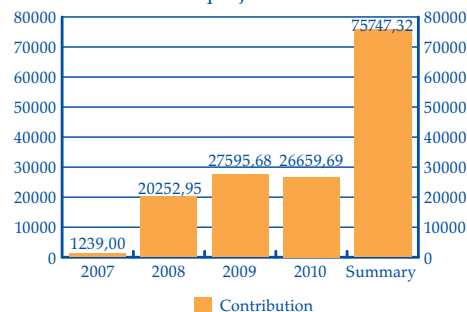
The project Save the Lives which is helping pregnant women and mothers in need celebrated in December 2010 its third anniversary. Since the beginning of the project we were able to help 43 women and their children and 36 babies were born. Of these, 34 infants remained with their mother and only two children went for adoption. Totally, we have been dealing with 540 cases for the last three years. Donors have contributed with more than 75,000 Euros. A hundred percent of the donated amount was remitted to help women and to save their children. This year we made a redesign of the project. Consulting centre for women and girls Alexis

Consulting centre for women and girls Alexis completed in early December first year of operation. Its aim is to provide advisory services. During this period, the project has been seeking to offer support and counselling services to girls and women who are considering abortion or are in serious situations related to pregnancy. For the first year 95 cases were processed, which were mostly related to unintended or risky pregnancy. The project involved over 27 experts in the field of social work, gynaecology, psychology, psychiatry, and others. A total of 160 contacts have been processed. The most common means of dealing the cases were telephone (49), then e-mail (37) and 9 cases of personal counselling. More at www.alexisporadna.sk.

Newsletter of the civic association Forum for Life

In 2010 the magazine Newsletter of the c. a. Forum for Life was issued for the seventh year in a quarterly period. Before the Day of the Conceived Child Forum for Life issued the first number of the Newsletter (1/2010) in which the main topic was that of a Woman's free choice. Number 2/2010 was published in May, bringing an interview with Marcela Dobešová, chairwoman of Forum for Life, who ran for election to parliament. In September Forum for Life issued the number 3/2010 with the theme from Marguerite A. Peeters titled "Impact of the Beijing Conference on a woman on developing countries". The December issue of the Newsletter of the c. a. Forum for Life 4/2010 brought, among other interesting things, photos of cycling pilgrimage to Bethlehem.

From 2010 onwards the Newsletter was issued with a full-colour cover and the back and with the two-tone contents. We are trying to provide our readers with so pleasant moments spent with our Newsletter as possible. The magazine was issued in the average printing of 8,250 pieces.

E-mail of Forum for Life

E-mail of Forum for Life was issued in 2010 17 times. This e-mail circular is sent to over

9,500 e-mail addresses and its main task is to inform our fans and supporters about our activities or about our needs.

The website has been operating continuously for eight years and it performs its function of the main information channel. Throughout the year, it has been updated, enriched with interesting articles and banners and photographs.

OVERVIEW OF OTHER ACTIVITIES

JANUARY

Seminar on an effective solution of infertility

On 29th January, 2010 the c.a. PloDar in collaboration with Forum for Life and the Centre for Family of the diocese of Banská Bystrica organized in Bratislava a seminar on an effective solution of infertility, miscarriages, cysts and premenstrual syndrome, which was designed especially for gynaecologists. The main lecturer was Dr. Phill Boyle from Ireland, President of the Fertility Care Centres of Europe, with 11 years of experience in providing care for infertile couples.

APRIL

Pilgrimage to St. Gianna

The V. year of the pilgrimage took place on 25th – 26th April 2010 in the Sacred Heart Church in Rajecké Teplice. Its main organizer is the non-profit organization Áno pre život (Yes for Life). Thanks to St. Gianna, who decided to bring a child into the world and thus succumb to serious illness, the pilgrimage means for Forum for Life the possibility of gathering new strength in its mission to protect human life from conception to natural death. The program began with the prayers of mothers and continued with the Holy Mass celebrated by Father Daniel Dian. This was followed by the silent adoration of the Holy Sacrament and prayers and songs of Taizé. The pilgrimage was attended by hundreds of pilgrims from the surrounding area but also from all over Slovakia.

MAY

Woman and Mental Health - Psychosocial and ethical aspects

On 12th May, 2010 the Department of Psychology and Pathopsychology of the Pedagogical Faculty of the Comenius University in Bratislava in cooperation with the Special section for responsible parenthood and family of Fórum života, c.a. organized an international seminar under the title: Woman and mental health, psychosocial and ethical aspects. The major speaker was a psychotherapist A. Lastmann from Australia, who has already ten years been devoted to treatment of women with post-abortion syndrome. Apart from her, also experts from Slovakia engaged in providing concrete assistance had their presentation on the seminar.

Family Day 2010

In 2010, the second year of the Family Day took place and the main organizer of this event was a Forum of Christian Institutions. Compared to the first year when this event took place only in Bratislava, this time there were involved cities all around Slovakia (Kosice, Šamorín, Levice, Lozorno - Abeland, Bratislava, Trnava, Pezinok, Nitra, Banská Bystrica, Žilina, Poprad, Prešov). Forum for Life was actively involved in organizing the Family Day to support marriage and family. In several places there were held cultural and social events in public places. Forum for Life was present there through its own information and education tables, presentations of member organizations and offers of information leaflets.

JUNE

Forum for Life at Festival Lumen

Forum for Life participated in the program of the largest gospel festival in Slovakia, which was held on 4th and 5th June, 2010 in Trnava, by the means of an information stand and organization of workshops. The workshop entitled „Does marriage still make sense?“ was visited by 250 young people.

Forum for Life at Festival Pohoda

Under the slogan “Well-being since conception” Forum for Life attended the festival already for the sixth time. It presented its information stand in which there were volunteers, social worker, psychologist and gynaecologist ready to discuss and offer information about the association and individual projects. It was also possible to make a photo of yourself at the original photo-wall aimed at promoting motherhood.

JULY – AUGUST

Cycling Pilgrimage to Bethlehem

The cycling pilgrimage “Prayers for conceived children of Slovakia” was organized by a team of volunteers from the village Lendak and this year continued to Bethlehem - the birthplace of Jesus Christ and also the city where the murder of children by the King Herod took place. The cycling pilgrimage started on 25th June, 2010 in Kežmarok and finished

on 6th August, 2010 in Tel Aviv. From Slovakia they passed through Hungary, Croatia, Serbia, Bulgaria, Greece, Turkey, Syria, Jordan to Israel.

SEPTEMBER

Walking pilgrimage to Šaštín

The community Život ako dar (Life as a Gift) together with Forum for Life organized from 13th – 15th September a pilgrimage from Trnava to Šaštín to save the life. It is a walking pilgrimage associated with prayers and sacrifices for the children conceived.

OKTOBER

The Bratislava City Mission

Forum for Life participated in Bratislava City Mission which lasted from 10th – 24th October, 2010, with the slogan: „God loves you even though you were on an abortion.“ Volunteers offered assistance designed to help women after abortion, but also to pregnant women surprised by unplanned pregnancy. In front of the hospitals Kramáre and Antolská in Petržalka they distributed over 500 leaflets offering assistance of the counselling centre Alexis (www.alexisporadna.sk). The week culminated with Saturday’s program at the Main Square, where Forum for Life offered the message of respect for life in its information and educational stand.

NOVEMBER

Slovak bishops celebrated the vigil for the life conceived

On 27th November, 2010 the Holy Father celebrated in the Basilica of St. Peter in Rome the “Vigil for every conceived human life”. He called to its celebration all the bishops of the world. Thus, in the prayer for the life conceived the whole world was united for the first time in the history. Forum for Life joined the mobilization of believers in Slovakia, when it gathered on its web site all vigils held in the territory of Slovakia.

DECEMBER

Benefits for mega casino definitively abolished

Forum for Life was throughout the year tirelessly engaged in public debate and in the support of the petition against the construction of mega casino Metropolis. The petition was on 7th September passed in parliament and for the period from 22th December, 2009 to first September, 2010 signed by 125,640 citizens.

On 8th December, 2010 the Parliament adopted an amendment to the law on gambling, which returned to the state’s legal status before 2009. Through this there has been legally released a special category of so called „Casino in the recreational complex“ and thus abolished the preferential conditions related to this type of casino. After one year’s effort of activities against the construction of the mega casino the most important reason for placing this project in Slovakia was cancelled.

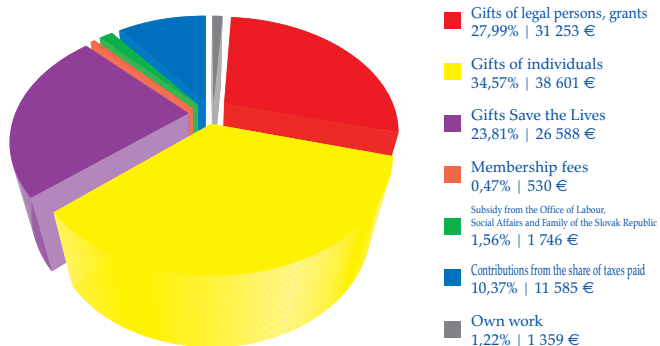

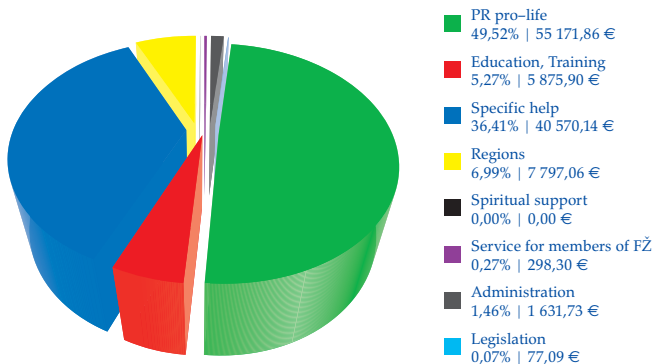
